## Guidelines for Postgraduate Credit Recognition

<b>All Postgraduate Programmes</b>
No credit is awarded through cross-credit or on the basis of non-credentialed prior learning for any postgraduate qualification.
<b>Masters programmes</b>
Candidates may apply for a transfer credit of no more than the equivalent of one half of one- year's full-time study.
<b>Bachelor Degrees with Honours (standalone)</b>
No credit.
<b>Postgraduate Diploma</b>
Candidates may apply for transfer credit of no more than 40 credits.
<b>Postgraduate Certificate</b>
Candidates may apply for a transfer credit of no more than 20 credits.
<b>Graduate Certificate</b>
Candidates may apply for a transfer credit of no more than 15 credits.
<b>Graduate Diploma</b>
Candidates may apply for a transfer credit of no more than 30 credits.
<b>Required to assess transfer credits</b>
Transcript: original or certified copy of academic record. Letter from the university or institution of higher learning that the course has not been credited to another qualification. Course Outline for the course.
<b>Process for the assessment of credits</b>
Collated information sent to the Faculty Academic Coordinator by Student Administration for assessment and the recommendation submitted to the Postgraduate Subcommittee. Credit only awarded if it ensures coherency of the overall course of study.
